



### Resident Courses

#### **1000 Course - Command Team MIO Issues, 20-24 Mar 17**

The aim of this course is to assist Command Team personnel in proficient conduct of MIO through the use of common standards

#### **2000 Course – Boarding Team Classroom Issues, 27-29 Mar 17**

The aim of this course is to train Boarding Team personnel in safely and efficiently apply NATO doctrines and procedures in MIO

#### **3000 Course - Boarding Team Practical Training, 30 Mar-07 Apr 17**

The aim of this course is to train Boarding Team personnel on how to conduct Boarding Ops in the framework of MIO through the common NATO Tactics, Techniques and Procedures (TTPs).

#### **6000 WMD in MIO, 24 Apr-05 May 17**

The aim of this course is to train and educate trainees in NATO practices and procedures regarding operational and tactical dimensions of WMD in Maritime Interdiction Operations.

#### **7000 Course - MIO in Support of Counter Piracy OPS, 06-10 Mar 17**

NMIOTC, taking into account the fact that piracy is an ongoing and potentially resurgent phenomenon and sensing the current operational and training needs, implemented this course, which is applicable for training units, teams and individuals who engage in the fight against piracy.

#### **12000 Course - C-IED Considerations in MIO, 27-31 Mar 17**

This course aims to educate and train international boarding team personnel in NATO TTPs and best practices to undertake expedient weapons intelligence tasks on board vessels and other maritime infrastructure in support of C-IED operations.

#### **14000 Course - Maritime-Improvised Explosive Device Disposal (M-IEDD), 03-07 Apr 17**

This course aims to educate and train qualified EOD personnel to competently undertake M-IEDD operations on-board vessels and other maritime infrastructure in support of C-IED or other Maritime Operations.

#### **16000 Maritime Aspects of Joint Operations, 22-26 May 17**

The course provides a general understanding of maritime aspects of Joint Operations to staff officers from tactical, operational or strategic NCS/NFS HQs without sufficient naval operational background.

#### **17000 Train-the-Trainers Technical Instructor Course, 23-31 Jan 17**

The course provides the attendees with the required tools necessary to improve their knowledge, skills, and experience in Special Teaching Subjects, get familiar with new Educational Technology, Micro-teaching planning and execution.

#### **19000 Cyber Security Awareness in Maritime Environment, 24-28 Apr 17**

Course aims to cover the requirement to confront the threats emanating from the abuse of the cyber domain by adversaries in the maritime environment.

#### **20000 Protection of Critical Maritime Infrastructure, 08-12 May 17**

Course aims to fulfil a capability gap and most importantly to contribute adequately to the protection of critical maritime infrastructure and to provide a series of planning considerations to conduct military operations involving C(M)I assets.
